ewy (Street Cry) made it three Group wins from four starts in Australia when he resumed with a hard-fought victory in yesterday's Bendigo Cup (Gr 3, 2400m).

Ridden by Kerrin McEvoy, who also rode the gelding to wins in last year's Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) and Sandown Cup (Listed, 3200m), Qewy (\$2.50) held off the late challenge of the Darren Weir-trained four-year-old Kiwia (Reset) (\$2.40 favourite) by a half neck.

The Lloyd Williams-owned Foundry (Galileo), who won The Metropolitan (Gr 1, 2400m) at Randwick on 30 September, was four and a quarter lengths away in third place in the field of seven. *Continued on page 2>>*

Continued from page 1 Qewy set a new course record, running 2:27.50 seconds for the 2400 metres race, his first victory in three starts since his 2016 Australian campaign.

Despite the impressive win by Qewy, his first start since an unplaced run in the Goodwood Cup (Gr 1, 2m) on 1 August in the UK, trainer Charlie Appleby's travelling foreman Chris Connett was reluctant to confirm a start in next week's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m).

Last year, Qewy ran fourth in the Melbourne Cup after winning the Geelong Cup at his first start in Australia but the Bendigo Cup came on the radar for the gelding after McEvoy was suspended for last week's Geelong feature.


Appleby wanted McEvoy, who has already won the Cranbourne Cup (Listed, 2025m) for the trainer with Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) placegetter Folkswood (Exceed And Excel) this spring, to partner Qewy for his first spring appearance.

McEvoy pushed up on Qewy from barrier two early, forcing Khartoum (Helenus) to work forward and take the lead, with Meet And Greet (Champions Gallery) and Big Memory (Duke Of Marmalade) to also cross the eventual winner early.

Qewy settled in fourth, with Foundry on his inside and Kiwia tracking the second favourite in the run.

"It's great to be back at Bendigo, especially after last year, and for Qewy to come out and win like he did is great," Connett told Racing.com.

"There was a couple of moments where my heart was in my mouth but he stays all day.



"The guys that have come down have really flourished and in the last couple of weeks Qewy's really started to blossom."

Connett said he would liaise with Appleby once he had assessed how Qewy had come through his Bendigo Cup victory before deciding on whether the horse would run in his second Melbourne Cup.

McEvoy said Qewy was a natural stayer, but did not have the class of some of the other Melbourne Cup contenders.

"It was nice to get on the back of this horse again, he was very game in a couple of wins last spring and it was a great run in the Melbourne Cup so I'm pleased to see him find his best form again today," McEvoy said.

"We got a nice trail and I stepped it up four furlongs out and got him into the race, we made Kiwia chase him and we were too strong.

"It's a big call whether to run him in the Cup but he stays so well so it's up to Charlie and he'd have to be a top-10 chance in the Cup."

Qewy has 53 kilograms in the Melbourne Cup and was not penalised by Racing Victoria chief handicapper Greg Carpenter for his Bendigo Cup victory. Qewy is now 21st in the order of entry for next Tuesday's \$6,000,000 race.

Runner-up Kiwia, a winner of six of his 11 starts for owner-breeder Gerry Ryan of Limerick Lane Thoroughbreds, loomed up for jockey Damian Lane like he was going to win.

The son of Reset (Zabeel) won his first start at Warrnambool on 3 May and raced through until 29 July before being freshened up for a tilt at the Bendigo Cup, a race won by the Weir-trained, Ryan-owned Puissance De Lune (Shamardal) in 2012.

Kiwia is likely to contest the VRC Queen Elizabeth Stakes (Gr 3, 2600m) at Flemington on 11 November, a race Puissance De Lune also won.

Meanwhile, Qewy (8 g Street Cry - Princess Nada by Barathea) has now won four races in stakes company with an overall record of 28 starts for six wins, four seconds and five thirds. He has earned prize money of \$874,765.

Bred by Darley and a 60,000 guineas purchase by Anthony Stroud at the 2014 Tattersalls Autumn Horses In Training Sale, Qewy is out of Listed winner Princess Nada (Barathea), herself a half-sister to champion racehorse and leading sire Dubawi (Dubai Millennium) and stakes-placed Dubai Queen (Kingmambo). She is also a sister to Lancashire Oaks (Gr 2, 1m 3f) winner Emirates Queen (Street Cry).

Their dam is Ireland's champion older mare of 1999 Zomaradah (Deploy), who was a Group One winner. Qewy is also from the same family as 1998 champion three-year-old in Britain, High-Rise (High Estate) and Listed winner Supremacy (Vettori).

Princess Nada's two foals to race, Qewy and Jordan Princess (Cape Cross), are both stakes winners. She has an unraced four-year-year-old brother to Qewy called Palace Gate (Street Cry). After not being covered for two years, Princess Nada had a colt by Shamardal (Giant's Causeway) this year.

Qewy is one of 114 stakes winners for the late Darley shuttler Street Cry (Machiavellian), who is also the sire of champion triple Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) winner Winx.

20 accept for Coolmore

The Coolmore Stud Stakes (registered as Ascot Vale Stakes) (Gr 1, 1200m) yesterday received a full field of 20 three-year-olds for the \$1,000,000 race. The James Cummingstrained unbeaten colt Viridine (Poet's Voice) drew barrier one for the straight course Flemington race, while stablemates Kementari (Lonhro) and Malahat (Exceed And Excel) drew barrier 12 and barrier eight respectively. The Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) winner Houtzen (I Am Invincible) drew barrier five, while the Peter and Paul Snowden-trained Dracarys (Snitzel) came up with the outside barrier (20).

Fillies hold key to Coolmore

Sydney trainer Gerald Ryan, who has Golden Rose Stakes (Gr 1, 1400m) winner Trapeze Artist (Snitzel) in the Coolmore Stud Stakes, says the Lindsay Park-trained fillies hold the key to the Group One race. Trapeze Artist drew barrier 18, while Lindsay Park's Catchy (Fastnet Rock) drew barrier 17, Formality (Fastnet Rock) drew gate two and Tulip (Pierro) came up with barrier 13. "I thought the fillies were the horses to beat," Ryan said from Sydney on Wednesday. "Catchy, Tulip and Formality all look very smart and all in great form leading into this," Ryan told Racing.com. "Tulip especially. She was huge in The Everest."

Hayes has soft spot for Catchy

Co-trainer Ben Hayes believes all three Lindsay Park fillies in Saturday's Coolmore Stud Stakes are genuine contenders, but admits to leaning to Blue Diamond Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) winner Catchy. Catchy is at \$7.50 in a capacity field of 20, while Tulip and Formality are at \$14. "I'm a bit of a Catchy fan. I've always loved her," Hayes said. "And she's always been a little bit better than Formality and Tulip. I think that might stay the same. I'm not saying I don't like the other ones. Catchy's just such a big strong filly and she gets the weight off the boys and she looks like a colt."

Melham riding Daysee in Myer

Former champion jockey and experienced trainer Ron Quinton says his apprentice Andrew Adkins understands the decision to give the ride on Daysee Doom (Domesday) in the Myer Classic (registered as Empire Rose Stakes) (Gr 1, 1600m) to Ben Melham. Adkins is the regular rider of the five-year-old mare, but Quinton said the task for the young apprentice in the Group One fillies and mares' race would be too much to ask at this stage of the jockey's career. "It's too much for the young bloke to absorb Derby day in Melbourne," Quinton said. "It wouldn't be quite fair to put him under that pressure so we decided to put a local rider on. Andrew would have liked to have had the opportunity but he understands the position."

Egg Tart tackles Kennedy Mile

Toorak Handicap (Gr 1, 1600m) winner Tosen Stardom (Deep Impact) headlines a field of 14 for the \$1,000,000 Kennedy Mile (registered as Cantala Stakes) (Gr 1, 1600m) and will jump from barrier nine. The Japanese import will be joined in Saturday's handicap at Flemington by his Darren Weir-trained stablemate Lucky Hussler (Husson) who has the widest barrier and will be backing up seven days after winning the Crystal Mile (Gr 2, 1600m). Premier Sydney trainer Chris Waller has six runners including mares Egg Tart (Sebring) (barrier 10), Omei Sword (High Chaparral) (eight) and Shillelagh (Savabeel) (two) who is fourth emergency for Saturday's Myer Classic.

Radipole a lightweight contender

Trainer Mike Moroney is hoping Radipole (Rock Of Gibraltar) can run a big race in the Kennedy Mile on Saturday under a featherweight. The four-year-old gelding was most recently seen running second in the Seymour Cup (Listed, 1600m) and he will start from barrier 11 with Patrick Moloney

booked to take the ride. "I'm a bit disappointed with his barrier draw," Moroney said. "That's going to make it tough but we just thought he would be a light weight chance. It's not that often you get the chance to run in a Group One handicap with 52 kilograms with a horse of his quality, because we do think he's going to make his way through. He's lightly raced and he's one of our better ones now he's acclimatised."

Busuttin unfazed by Victoria Derby barriers

Co-trainer Trent Busuttin is unfazed by the barrier draws dealt to his Victoria Derby (Gr 1, 2500m) contenders Main Stage (Reliable Man) and Sully (Reliable Man). UCI Stakes (Listed, 1800m) winner Main Stage drew barrier 14 in the field of 16 plus one emergency while stablemate Sully, who ran third last start in the Spring Champion Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m), drew barrier 15. The third of Busuttin's Victoria Derby runners, Johnny Vinko (Savabeel), drew barrier four. "There is nothing you can do about the draw as it is what it is," Busuttin said. "We have the horses at peak fitness and we were delighted with their work on Tuesday, so it will be up to the riders to make of it what they will."

Waller chasing second Derby

Chris Waller has added winkers to the gear of Tangled (Snitzel) as the trainer attempts to win his second Victoria Derby at Flemington on Saturday. Tangled has finished runner-up in the Spring Champion Stakes and the Caulfield Classic (Gr 3, 2000m) at his past two starts, with Waller making the gear change for the Group One race. It was the same gear change he made with success to 2014 Victoria Derby winner Preferment (Zabeel). "He worked well in the winkers and he'll wear them in the Derby," Waller said. "I feel he's had a good preparation for a Derby. He's a nice strong horse, well-bred. He's got a good attitude and we've got a good in-form jockey."

Kaonic to miss Carbine Club

Carbine Club Stakes (Gr 3, 1600m) favourite Kaonic (Savabeel), a winner of his past two starts in Sydney, is expected to be scratched from the \$200,000 race at Flemington on Saturday. The Chris Waller-trained colt has been struck down with an elevated temperature and will be spelled for the autumn.

Moroney hoping to skip Lexus with Vengeur Masque

Trainer Mike Moroney is hoping that he will not have to run Vengeur Masque (Monsun) in the Lexus Stakes (registered as Hotham Handicap) (Gr 3, 2500m) on Saturday, but he currently sits on 30 in the order of entry for Tuesday's Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m). The winner of the Lexus Stakes gains automatic entry to the \$6,000,000 race but Moroney is hoping some of the current entries will defect to leave the door open for the Geelong Cup (Gr 3, 2400m) winner.

Bring Me Roses accepts for Wakeful

The Tony McEvoy-trained Bring Me Roses (High Chaparral) headlines the 16 fillies that accepted for the Wakeful Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Flemington on Saturday. The three-year-old will line up in the race off the back of a dominant last start victory in the Edward Manifold Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) and she will race from barrier 11 with Mark Zahra booked to take the ride. She will line up alongside the Mick Price-trained Hiyaam (High Chaparral), who finished second in the Edward Manifold Stakes. The surprise non-acceptor in the field was the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian Bott-trained Pinot (Pierro).

12 in Begonia Belle Stakes

A total of 12 mares have accepted for Saturday's Begonia Belle Stakes (Gr 3, 1100m) at Flemington,

including the Lindsay Park-trained Group One winner Sheidel (Holy Roman Emperor). The six-year-old mare was last seen running fifth in the Schillaci Stakes (Gr 2, 1100m) and she has drawn barrier one for Blake Shinn. Other notable entries include Group Two winner Savanna Amour (Love Conquers All) and talented south Australian mare Desert Lashes (Reward For Effort), who have drawn barriers seven and five respectively.

Moloney hoping for dividend with Rich Charm

Jockey Patrick Moloney hopes he can deliver trainer Udyta Clarke a big race win on one of the biggest days when he partners Rich Charm (Danerich) in the Linlithgow Stakes (Gr 2, 1200m) at Flemington on Saturday. Rich Charm was most recently seen winning the Italktravel Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield on 18 October and he will face 14 rivals in the \$300,000 race, including Testa Rossa Stakes (Listed, 1200m) winner Bons Away (Bon Hoffa). "Mrs Clarke has always been a really strong supporter of mine since I was an apprentice so to be associated with her and have the chance to give her one of her biggest thrills in racing with a Group Two, it would be quite special," Moloney told Racing.com. "She deserves all the luck she gets because everything she does is about the horse, not herself. Click here to view Saturday's Flemington acceptances.

Hartnell confirmed for Melbourne Cup

Owner Godolphin yesterday said Hartnell (Authorized) would contest next week's Melbourne Cup, his third start in the race. Now trained by James Cummings, Hartnell was unplaced in 2015 and ran third in last year's race. Hartnell won the P B Lawrence Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) first up this preparation before twice finishing runner-up at Group One level. Last start, Hartnell finished ninth in the Caulfield Stakes (Gr 1, 2000m) on 14 October. "To have a Melbourne Cup runner for Sheikh Mohammed is a great honour and is also a credit to our team here in Australia who have got Hartnell to a level where he is a genuine contender," Cummings said.

Williams partners Wall Of Fire in gallop

Jockey Craig Williams was yesterday at :

Werribee Quarantine Centre to partner his Melbourne Cup ride, the Hugo Palmer-trained Wall Of Fire (Canford Cliffs), in a track gallop. The European import had his first start in Australia when runner-up in the Herbert Power Stakes (Gr 2, 2400m) at Caulfield on 14 October, "I was shattered when Admire Deus broke down as he was an exceptional horse, so we had to work on plan B," Williams said. "I was lucky enough to come down and ride Tiberian last week and at the same time Wall Of Fire. I wasn't in the position where I had any extra time to wait and see how they progressed further into their preparations and one of the connections and the trainer wanted to sew up their jockey so I had to make a decision that day. I decided on Wall Of Fire and I'm very happy with that decision since."

Owner Williams could have eight in Cup

Owner Lloyd Williams could have as many as eight runners in the Melbourne Cup on Tuesday as he attempts to win the Flemington showcase for the sixth time. Team Williams has eight runners inside the top 30 of the 36 horses still in contention for next Tuesday's race with six safely inside the field limit of 24. Victory by Aloft (Galileo) in Saturday's Lexus Stakes would see the stayer also secure a starting berth in the \$6,000,000 race. International raiders Johannes Vermeer (Galileo), Rekindling (High Chaparral) and US Army Ranger (Galileo) will be joined by last year's Cup winner Almandin (Monsun) and Bondi Beach (Galileo) while a start is dependant on the weather for Gallante (Montjeu).

Chautauqua and Vega Magic to run in Darley

Team Hawkes and Lindsay Park yesterday confirmed their respective Group One-winning sprinters Chautauqua (Encosta De Lago) and Vega Magic (Lope De Vega) would take their place in next week's Darley Classic (registered as VRC Sprint) (Gr 1, 1200m). Chautauqua, who finished fourth in The Everest (1200m), was a late scratching from the Manikato Stakes (Gr 1, 1200m) at Moonee Valley last Friday. Vega Magic, runner-up in The Everest, ran fifth as favourite in the Manikato Stakes.

Redzel on track for Darley

Trainer Peter Snowden says The Everest winner Redzel (Snitzel) can lay claim to being Australia's best sprinter and that the fiveyear-old can enhance his reputation when he contests next week's Darley Classic. Redzel has been kept fresh since winning the \$10,000,000 The Everest, with the stable electing to bypass the Manikato Stakes last week. Redzel instead was given a jump out at Flemington last Friday. "He deserves to get the best sprinter around at the moment," Snowden said. "I think two weeks ago he put his name up there as that. He's probably been flying under the radar for quite a while now but I think that win really cemented his place and this one could top it right off if he could pick this one up."

Perth juvenile to run in Maribyrnong Plate

Western Australian two-year-old filly Agent Pippa (Demerit), a first start winner at Ascot on 21 October, will fly to Melbourne on Monday ahead of the Maribyrnong Plate (Gr 3, 1000m) at Flemington on 11 November. The Daniel and Ben Pearce-trained filly, who also won a Lark Hill barrier trial prior to her debut, has been purchased by Melbourne businessman Rod Menzies. After the Maribyrnong Plate, Agent Pippa will return to Perth to be prepared for the \$500,000 Karrakatta Plate (Gr 2, 1200m) next year.

Melbourne trip on cards for Sky Boy

Co-trainers Anthony and Edward Cummings have said they now intend to aim Sky Boy (Pendragon) at the TV Curve Stakes (registered as Batman Stakes) (Listed, 1800m) at Flemington next Thursday. The gelding scored the second victory of his career when he won

the Pluck at Vinery Handicap (1550m) at Canterbury yesterday. "They all seem to really furnish quite well with a trip down there so I think it will be quite good for him. The nice open spaces of either Flemington or Sandown would be fine," said Edward Cummings. "He's really gone from strength to strength this preparation. He's still quite raw but he's a lovely mover. He'll develop into an even nicer horse in six months' time."

Cliff's Edge could run in Emirates

Three-year-old Clff's Edge (Canford Cliffs) could take on older horses in next week's Emirates Stakes (registered as LKS Mackinnon Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington. Trainer Darren Weir is considering running the colt against older horses in the Group One race, which could include Winx (Street Cry). Cliff's Edge won the Caulfield Classic (registered as Norman Robinson Stakes) (Gr 3, 2000m) on 21 October before backing up a week later to finish runner-up to filly Aloisia (Azamour) in the Moonee Valley Vase (Gr 2, 2040m) last Saturday.

Swampland could be spelled

Trainer Henry Dwyer is considering immediately spelling four-year-old Swampland (Redwood), a stakes-placed mare who was balloted out of Saturday's Myer Classic. Swampland, who won twice at Flemington during the winter, was runner-up in the Let's Elope Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) at the same track on 16 September. Last start, Swampland ran eighth in the Tristarc Stakes (Gr 2, 1400m) on 21 October.

Bayliss suspended

Jockey Regan Bayliss was yesterday suspended for careless riding for his winning ride on Saddle The Sun (Helmet) at Bendigo yesterday. Racing Victoria stewards handed Bayliss a seven-meeting suspension, which rules him out of riding Ventura Storm (Zoffany) in Tuesday's Melbourne Cup. Bayliss has indicated he will appeal the suspension, which starts after the Victoria Derby meeting on Saturday and expires after the VRC Oaks meeting at Flemington on 9 November.

Pearce resigns from ATC

Australian Turf Club (ATC) chief executive Darren Pearce has resigned and will depart the organisation on 30 November. Pearce, who was initially the chief executive of the Australian Jockey Club prior to its merger with the Sydney Turf Club, has been in racing administration for 12 years. Pearce, who joined the Australian Jockey Club as chief financial officer in 2005, said the recent success of the \$10,000,000 The Everest (1200m) and the healthy financial position of the ATC made it a perfect time to leave on a high. "For a racing fan, it has been a tremendous privilege to lead the ATC through a period of positive change, and for it to now be considered one of the world's leading racing businesses," Pearce said. "It's a great turnaround story that is set to get better as the club further invests in tracks, stables and facilities."

Acting ATC chief executives appointed

The ATC has moved quickly to temporarily appoint James Heddo and Matt Galanos as joint-chief executives when Darren Pearce vacates his position on 30 November. Heddo, who is currently executive general manager racing services and membership, has almost 30 years' experience in racing administration including seven years as chief executive of the Gosford Racing Club. Galanos joined the ATC in 2013 as chief financial officer, a position he retains. Galanos also leads the ATC's hospitality and events team.

Work starts at Eagle Farm

Remedial work on the Eagle Farm racetrack course proper is set to begin. Contractor FKG has made preparations for the work on the track which has been closed since May when it was deemed unsuitable for racing. Work is scheduled to begin tomorrow with sections of the existing top layer of the track to be removed before preparation of a profile for the new turf. Racing Queensland met with the Queensland branch of the Australian Trainers Association this week and assured them a return to Eagle Farm racing was still planned for the end of April. A track remediation project control group is collaborating on all aspects of the project.

Case against Currie withdrawn

The Queensland Racing Integrity Commission (QRIC) has withdrawn a positive swab charge against Toowoomba trainer Ben Currie. Last year, Currie was found guilty of presenting Tints (Tycoon Ruler) at Rockhampton in April 2016 while the horse was found to contain the prohibited substance boldenone. Currie was fined \$6,000 but appealed, raising procedural matters and a claim a hair sample from Tints was negative. His appeal against the decision was to be heard by the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal but QRIC has decided not to proceed with the matter. A second appeal by Currie for presenting Party Till Dawn (All Bar One) with a prohibited substance, methamphetamine, at Toowoomba in July last year will proceed.

New Zealand

Bosson to say in New Zealand

Jockey Opie Bosson will not make the trip to Australia to ride Gingernuts (Iffraaj) in the Emirates Stakes (LKS Mackinnon Stakes) (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington on 11 November. Bosson will stay to ride in the New Zealand Two Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) meeting and the ride on Gingernuts will be taken by Hugh Bowman, provided Winx (Street Cry) does not take her place in the race.

Marsh targets Guineas races with pair

Trainer Stephen Marsh will be represented in both the New Zealand Two Thousand Guineas and New Zealand One Thousand Guineas (Gr 1, 1600m) at Riccarton on 11 November. Marsh will saddle Group Two winner Sumstreetsumwhere (Highly Recommended) in the Two Thousand Guineas, while stakes-placed filly Campari (O'Reilly) will run in the fillies equivalent, where she will be joined in the race by her stablemate Pierrocity (Pierro). "Sumstreetsumwhere has come through his last race in great style," Marsh said. "He hasn't struck one on race day, but his gallops at home on better ground have been good."

Hezthewonforus wins first start

Jockey Mark Du Plessis was pleased with the way Hezthewonforus (Sufficient) secured his first win on debut at Avondale yesterday. The three-year-old colt had no problems throughout the race, eventually going on to score an eight length victory over Each Way (Pour Moi) in the Avondale Sunday Markets Maiden (1400m). "I didn't think I would be in front from barrier rise, but he's learned from the trials and won like I thought he could," Du Plessis said. "He's a big baby, but he's got a fair motor."

Mongolian Beauty breaks through

Mongolian Beauty (Fastnet Rock) finally broke through for her maiden victory in the Jockey Club Members Maiden Stakes (1400m) at Avondale yesterday. The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained three-year-old, who was having the seventh start of her career, ran on strongly all the way to line to defeat Eurostar (Dalghar) by half a length. "It was good to see her really knuckle down and hit the line like that," Forsman said. She'll be better in the autumn and when she learns to relax and gets up over ground I think you'll see a really good horse."

Blizzard retired

The decision has been taken to retire the consistent Blizzard (Any Suggestion) after the gelding's unplaced last up run over 1600 metres at Ellerslie on Saturday. The seven-year-old won six races and made his mark in black type company with second placings in both the Championship Stakes (Gr 2, 2000m) at Ellerslie and the Karaka Classic (Listed, 1600m) at Pukekohe. "He's done such a good job for the owners," co-trainer Emma-Lee Browne said. "There's nothing wrong with him, age is catching up and we didn't want to keep running him until he drops down the grades."

Asia

Lor saddles first treble

New trainer Frankie Lor continued his dream start to his Hong Kong training career when he sent out his first treble at Sha Tin yesterday evening. He combined with Karis Teetan to take the Class Five Tsim Mei Fung Handicap (1200m) with Foxbat (Foxwedge) and the Class Four Tiu Yue Yung Handicap (1650m) with Imperial Concorde (High Chaparral), while Joao Moreira-ridden Diamond Friends (Intense Focus) was the middle pin of the treble in the Class Five Wa Mei Shan Handicap (1650m). "In never expected I could win so many races in such a short time, I am very happy," Lor said. "Some horses have improved this season for one reason or another, but other horses were on the right mark and ready to win when they came to me, and I have just been lucky enough to get them now."

First-phase dual-site trainers named for Conghua Training Centre

The Hong Kong Jockey Club announced yesterday the nine trainers allocated stables at its Conghua Training Centre (CTC), opening in Q3 2018. Dual-site trainers for the first phase of CTC are: Tony Cruz, Caspar Fownes, John Moore, Paul O'Sullivan, Danny Shum, John Size, Chris So, Me Tsui and Dennis Yip. Operations at CTC will gradually increase, with more trainers to be designated as dual-site operators in subsequent phases. "The Conghua Training Centre is one of the most significant projects in the Club's history and it is exciting to share the names of the dual-site trainers, which will be the first to operate a stable based in the Chinese Mainland," Anthony Kelly, executive director, racing business and operations. "It will truly be a world-class venue for thoroughbred training."

International

Back-to-back wins for Guignol

Talented entire Guignol (5 h Cape Cross - Guadalupe by Monsun) landed the Grosser Preis von Bayern (Gr 1, 2400m) for the second successive year in Munich yesterday. The entire came into the race off the back of a fine victory in the Grosser Preis von Baden (Gr 1, 2400m) and yesterday he continued his brilliant run of form when he defeated Iquitos (Adlerflug) by a neck with the same distance back to Dschingis Secret (Soldier Hollow) in third. This was a third Group One win for Guignol and he is one of 13 top-level winners for the late Darley sire Cape Cross (Green Desert), who died earlier this year.

15 for Dream Ahead

Aquis Farm shuttler Dream Ahead (Diktat) sired his 15th stakes winner yesterday, when the Pierre-Charles Boudot-trained Sweety Dream (2 f ex Excellent Girl by Exceed and Excel) landed the Prix Miesque (Gr 3, 1400m) at Maisons-Laffitte. The two-year-old filly bounced back from a disappointing run on her second career start, having won on debut in September. Yesterday, she regained her winning thread when she defeated Seaella (Canford Cliffs) by half a length with another length back to Moisson Precoce (Lawman) in third. Dream Ahead stands at Aquis Farm for a fee of \$19,800 (inc GST).

The Right Man defends his crown

The Didier Guillemin-trained The Right Man (5 g Lope de Vega - Three Owls by Warning) succesfully defended his Prix De Seine-Et-Oise (Gr 3, 1200m) crown at Maisons-Laffitte. The five-year-old gelding had not won since he took out the Al Quoz Sprint (Gr 1, 1200m) at Meydan in March, but yesterday he stormed back into form to beat Gold Vibe by one and three quarter lengths, with Son Cesio a further short head back in third. The Right Man is one of 30 stakes winners for Lope De Vega (Shamardal).

Jack Hobbs retired to Overbury

Irish Derby (Gr 1, 1m4f) winner Jack Hobbs (Halling) has been retired and will stand at Overbury Stud in Gloucestershire for a fee of £4,000. The five-year-old, who remains in the ownership of Godolphin and the partners who raced him, added a second top-level victory to his tally earlier this year when he won the Dubai Sheema Classic (Gr 1, 2410m). Simon Sweeting, manager of Overbury said: "I am overjoyed that Jack Hobbs is coming to Overbury.

He's a magnificent stamp with an outcross pedigree, and he's the best racehorse to retire straight to the National Hunt ranks in Britain since Sheikh Mohammed sent us Kayf Tara back in 2001."

Lope De Vega fee increased

Ballylinch Stud linchpin Lope De Vega has been given a fee increase to €60,000 for the upcoming breeding season. Lope De Vega has enjoyed a good year in both hemispheres, siring four Group One winners, including Vega Magic and Santa Ana Lane. "Lope De Vega has established himself as a leading international sire and in 2018 his biggest and best crop will start to hit the track so the future looks very positive for him," said Ballylinch managing director John O'Connor. Meanwhile, Lope De Vega's barnmate New Bay (Dubawi) who stands in partnership with both Juddmonte and the China Horse Club. remains on a fee of €20,000 for his second season on covering duty.

Mulcaster active on day three

Guy Mulcaster, who was working on behalf of trainer Chris Waller, was active on the third day of the Tattersalls Horses In Training Sale and at the time of going to press Mulcaster had snapped up five horses, to add to his one purchase on Tuesday. The most expensive of these yesterday was Lot 873, Brimham Rocks (Fastnet Rock), who has won three of his ten career starts and he was offered by trainer Ralph Beckett's Kimpton Down Stables. "We had identified this horse on his form earlier this summer - it's been a struggle this week, so it's good to buy one," said Mulcaster. "We'll ship him down, get him into the system and acclimatise him. We'll take it step by step and see how he gets on - there will not be any big targets."

Naval Warfare purchased for 160,000gns

Naval Warfare (Born To Sea) was also purchased by Guy Mulcaster on behalf of Chris Waller Tattersalls Horses In Training Sale yesterday. A winner of three of his nine career starts and catalogued as Lot 957, Naval Warfare is a half-brother to Group Two winner and now sire Gregorian (Clodovil) and he was sold by trainer Andrew Balding's Park House Stables. Mulcaster also paid 100,000 guineas for three-time winner Opposition (Dalakhani), who was catalogued as Lot 913 and consigned by Ed Dunlop Racing.

Tansheet makes 110,000gns

After purchasing Alward (Aqlaam) for 35,000 guineas from the Shadwell draft at last year's Tattersalls Horses In Training Sale, Guy Mulcaster snapped up his half-brother Tansheet (Shamardal) from the same draft at this year's renewal for 110,000 guineas yesterday. Catalogued as Lot 1017, the colt looks set to join his half-brother, who was most recently seen running second in the City Tattersalls Club Cup (Listed, 2400m), at Waller's stable in Australia. Two-year-old Tansheet has run three times, breaking his maiden on his second start at Newcastle in September.

Matthew Smith takes home Fierce Impact

Fierce Impact, a winning son of champion Japanese sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence), was purchased by New South Wales-based trainer Matthew Smith for 120,000 guineas at the Tattersalls Horses In Training Sale in Newmarket yesterday. Catalogued as Lot 1038, the colt is out of the Grade Three winner Keiai Gerbera (Smarty Jones), while further back he is from the same family as Grade Three winner Boundary (Danzig). He was sold by Jamie Railton as agent for Qatar Racing.

International traffic fuels strong Horses In Training trade

he number of international departures from Tattersalls during Tuesday's session of the Autumn Horses In Training Sale would have given most major airports a run for their money, with horses that changed hands now bound for the likes of Australia, Hong Kong, Norway and the US.

An international campaign could also be on the agenda for Pivoine in due course, after Alastair Donald went to 340,000 guineas to secure the son of Redoute's Choice (Danehill) from the Ballymacoll Stud dispersal draft after a protracted duel with Australian agent Guy Mulcaster.

"He's a lovely horse that we've followed for a while and I think there's a lot more to come from him," said Donald, who acquired the three-year-old on behalf of an established but undisclosed client.

"He's run some very good times and has shown an excellent turn of foot. The Australians were underbidders and there's every chance this could be a horse to be campaigned internationally at some point, though he'll remain in Britain for the time being."

Pivoine, who was catalogued as **Lot 691**, made obvious appeal to the Antipodean market, not only as a son of the dominant Australian sire of the era but also being out of a winning half-sister to the dam of Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) winner Fiorente (Monsun).

The gelding won three times for Sir Michael Stoute, including when recording back-to-back successes at Kempton and Doncaster on his most recent outings.

Earlier in the session Donald also went to 200,000 guineas for Battered (Foxwedge) from the William Haggas draft, with the three-time winner also bound for foreign shores.

"He'll go to the Dubai Carnival - he has the right rating to get into those races but still looks fairly treated," said Donald. "He looks progressive, tough, versatile and he's run very good times on his last two starts - you have to be bordering on stakes-class to run those sort of figures. He's a very good physical to boot."

The three-year-old son of Foxwedge (Fastnet Rock), who was catalogued as **Lot 66**, was last seen finishing runner-up to Kryptos

(Cacique), an effort that earned him a Racing Post Rating (RPR) of 104.

Anthony Stroud made a pair of noteworthy acquisitions during the session, the most expensive of which was **Lot 715** Eynhallow, with the agent going to 300,000 guineas to land the progressive son of Nathaniel (Galileo), who will next be seen in Dubai.

"He'll go to the Carnival," said Stroud. "He's a lovely horse bred by the McCreerys, is highly progressive and has been well trained. He's gone up about 20 pounds this year so fits the right profile for Dubai."

The three-year-old, who was never out of the first four from seven starts this season for Roger Charlton, is a half-brother to Jersey Stakes winner and Irish National Stud resident Gale Force Ten (Oasis Dream). His race record also features two wins and a peak RPR of 100.

Stroud also went to 220,000 guineas for Jupiter Light (Lonhro) from John Gosden's Clarehaven Stables. The three-year-old Lonhro (Octagonal) gelding won three times, including when awarded a Nottingham handicap (1m2f) last time out. He was catalogued as Lot 633.

"He was recommended by the trainer," said Stroud of George Strawbridge's homebred. "He vetted well and has the profile for Dubai and the right rating."

Regular Autumn Horses In Training Sale purchasers Red Baron's Barn and Rancho Temescal were back in action sourcing stock to take back to California, and high on their list was dual winner Eldritch (Dark Angel), who they picked up for 200,000 guineas. The gelding was catalogued as **Lot 631**.

"We're looking for a strong allowance horse," said the operation's Tim Cohen, who went on to explain where the peculiar moniker originated.

"My father races under Red Baron. He used to do some advising for athletes out in California and instead of paying him they gifted him part of a restaurant called Red Baron. It was a terrible gift as, of course, it lost money!

"We bought six head here last year and we've been coming on or off for 30 years or so. A horse we got here last year called Force won a nice race for us at Golden Gate a little while ago, and Zaffinah won two races for us."

Cohen said he would be returning to Del Mar before the end of the sale to see Red

Baron's Itsinthepost (American Post) line up in the Breeders' Cup Turf (Gr 1, 1m2f) on Saturday.

"I watched the draw last night at about one in the morning, we got the seven hole so that's good. We're hoping for a big run," added Cohen.

David O'Meara has forged his reputation through revitalising cast-offs from other yards, and the North Yorkshire-based handler acquired a number of new recruits through his assistant trainer Jason Kelly during the session. Among the most eye-catching was Escobar (Famous Name), who cost 100,000 guineas from the draft of Hugo Palmer.

"He's a horse who was high-class at two and just seemed to lose his way a little bit, but they can often be the horses we do well with," said Kelly after a bit of gentle ribbing from underbidder, Tom Malone.

"He'll have the winter off and we'll see what we can do with him - he'll be straight in at a high level next year though. He's been bought for Tiffin Sandwiches, who have an unraced Dawn Approach filly and a horse called Royal Headley with us."

Escobar, a son of Famous Name (Dansili), won the Listed Washington Singer Stakes (Listed, 7f) as a two-year-old and boasts a peak RPR of 107 and he was catalogued as **Lot 683**.

The O'Meara team will be hoping that he can follow in the footsteps of Lord Glitters (Whipper), a €270,000 buy from Arqana in July who produced a remarkable last-to-first effort to land the Balmoral Handicap (1m) on British Champions Day.

"That was fantastic as the owner paid quite a bit of money for him but he's got most of that back now!" said Kelly. "We have a couple of

Listed races in mind for him and that will give us an idea of where we can go next year."

On the day that it was announced that Frankel (Galileo) had earned himself a hefty increase in covering fee, upped by £50,000 to £175,000, his smart son Learn By Heart was bought for 160,000 guineas by Bent Olsen to continue his career in Scandinavia.

"I wanted a young horse that could go for all the best races in Norway and Denmark," said Denmark-based Olsen, whose stable is home to around 40 thoroughbreds.

"Hopefully you'll see him in the Norwegian Derby! And of course, everyone wants a Frankel. I think they will get better as they get older."

Catalogued as Lot 671, Learn By Heart was bred by the Queen out of the Cherry Hinton Stakes (Gr 2, 6f) winner Memory (Danehill Dancer), lineage that makes the colt inbred

3x3 to Danehill (Danzig) and a close relation to Acomb Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) winner Recorder (Galileo) and the Listed-winning Call To Mind (Galileo), with his siblings both being sons of Galileo (Sadler's Wells).

Learn By Heart won one of his five starts for William Haggas, and achieved an RPR of 99 when fourth to Hey Gaman (New Approach) in a Newbury Listed event in August.

The second session saw 270 lots bring turnover of 7,668,300 guineas, an average of 33,195 guineas - a five per cent increase on the comparative figure from 2016 - and a median of 18,000 guineas - down five per cent from 19,000 guineas.

The clearance rate stood at 86 per cent.

Winx joins Kingston Town, yet does not match her peak rating





ost questions about the talent of Winx (Street Cry) [134] had been answered in 21 consecutive wins but Saturday's Cox Plate (Gr 1, 2040m) was about her reaching another level as she sought to join one of the immortals Kingston Town (Bletchingly) [137] as a three-time winner of the famous Moonee Valley race, writes Adam Blencowe.

And while Winx succeeded in winning she did so with a rating of 126, which was eight pounds below her 134-rated best, in defeating Humidor (Teofilo) [129], a horse that conceded her two kilograms, by a long neck.

Since Kingston Town there has not been a middle-distance horse in Australia good enough to make Winx's 134 peak rating a requirement for victory and certainly nothing among the beaten brigade on Saturday had the tools to demand that much of the champion mare.

Could she have run to 134 had Kingston Town come forward as the challenger as opposed to Humidor?

We would have to think not.

Winx ran track record time on Saturday and she did it finishing fast, but so too did Humidor, with that pair going to the post more than four lengths clear of the third-placed Folkswood (Exceed And Excel) [120].

Rating racehorses is about taking what we already know about horses and updating our assessment as more information comes to hand. Every race provides a wealth of new information but it should not be taken at the expense of the prior knowledge.

Winx probably could not have run to 134 on a track as fast as it was on Saturday (Racing and Sports' assessment of the track was on the firm side of the official Good 3) with her best ratings being been taken when there is a bit more give in the ground.

The fast raw time of 2:02.94 speaks as much of the fast conditions as to a fast performance

with the speed figures from Winx's three Cox Plate wins being in direct contrast to their raw overall times.

Winx's raw time of 2:02.98 in her first Cox Plate win in 2015 earned a time rating of 128 (after considering the track speed of the day) while a near identical 2:02.94 in 2017 returned a time rating of 117 and a Timeform rating to Winx of 126p.

It then took Winx 2:06.35 to win the 2016 Cox Plate, which was run on a Soft 5 track, but it earned her one of the best adjusted times in the modern era with a time figure of 132 resulting in a Timeform rating to Winx of 133p.

She then followed that peak by taking it to her current Timeform peak rating of 134, achieved in winning the highly competitive 2017 George Ryder Stakes (Gr 1, 1500m) on Heavy 10 track at Rosehill in March.

Humidor [129] had a perfect run on Saturday under an inspired ride by Blake Shinn, but he could hardly be considering unlucky, having produced a career-peak 129 rating, a figure often sufficient to win a Cox Plate.

It was surprising that Humidor got as close to Winx as he did, but blinkers and a brilliant ground-saving ride squeezed the absolute best

out of Humidor who had already posted two genuine Group One performances in 2017.

Humidor ran to 125+ when overcoming the pattern of the day in a strong Australian Cup (Gr 1, 2000m) at Flemington in March and 126 with his impressive last-to-first win in the Makybe Diva Stakes (Gr 1, 1600m) at Flemington in September.

The fact that Humidor's three best performances have come in the three fastest races that he has contested would be no coincidence.

Folkswood's third for Godolphin edged his 119 peak rating from his recent Cranbourne Cup (Listed, 2025m) up to 120.

While the three-year-old Royal Symphony (Domesday) [116] matched his pre-race peak of 116 with his game fourth and did so despite a less than ideal run and could prove up to much better in the long term.

However, Royal Symphony was not the highest-rated three-year-old performance on Saturday's Moonee Valley card.

That honour went to the Moonee Valley Vase (Gr 2, 2040m) winner Aloisia (Azamour) [119] with her impressive win over Cliff's Edge (Canford Cliffs) [116] in a time of 2:04.24,

the fastest for the race since Moonee Valley switched to StrathAyr by over a second.

Again that demonstrates just how fast the track was playing on Saturday - only three times in 22 years has the overall time for the Moonee Valley Vase bettered 2:06.

Winx time in this year's Cox Plate was 7.5 lengths quicker than the Moonee Valley Vase on raw times, and 27.5 lengths faster than her Cox Plate win in 2016 and 18 lengths faster than her 2015 victory.

Of course we have already made a point of how raw times can mean little but it is an illustration of how good this year's Moonee Valley Vase was and how good Winx has been in her previous two Cox Plates.

With the Gai Waterhouse and Adrian
Bott-trained filly Pinot (Pierro) [105] now
closest on ratings to Aloisia in the VRC Oaks
(Gr 1, 2500m). That showpiece race on next
Thursday's Flemington card looks to be hers

2C Exceed And Excel (AUS)-Gavroche (AUS)(Snippets (AUS))

2C Snitzel (AUS)-Bondi Blonde (AUS)(Red Ransom (USA))

with a similar performance over the longer trip.

Yankee Rose (All American) went into last year's VRC Oaks rated 120 and was beaten. But Samantha Miss (Redoute's Choice) [122], Miss Finland (Redoute's Choice) [120], Serenade Rose (Stravinski) [119] and Special Harmony (Spinning World) [120] are the only others to head to the race rated as highly in the past 20 years and all four won.





Two-year-olds

In winning the Racing Post Trophy (Gr 1, 1m) at Doncaster on Saturday, **Saxon Warrior** (2 c Deep Impact - Maybe by Galileo) not only provided his trainer Aidan O'Brien with his record-breaking 26 Group / Grade One winners this season, but the win also handed his sire Deep Impact (Sunday Silence) with his 32nd Group / Grade One winner.

The son of Deep Impact travelled powerfully to the front but looked like being denied as the John Gosden-trained Roaring Lion (Kitten's Joy) took it up with around a furlong to run.

Saxon Warrior was not to be beaten though and, as Roaring Lion wandered under pressure, Ryan Moore was able to regain the advantage in the dying strides aboard the 13-8 favourite and deliver a moment of racing history.

O'Brien also took third-place honours with The Pentagon (Galileo), who finished a further two and a half lengths behind the leading pair.

Elsewhere that day, the Charlie Hills-trained **Nebo** (2 c Kodiac - Kindling by Dr Fong) won the Horris Hill Stakes (Gr 3, 7f) at Newbury.

The two-year-old colt has finished second at Group Two level on three occasions this season including on his most recent appearance in the Criterium de Maisons-Laffitte (Gr 2, 1200m) on 13 October.

Nebo tracked the leaders and when Frankie

Dettori asked him for his effort with a furlong left to travel he hit the front and showed a smart turn of foot to defeat Tangled (Society Rock) by half a length, with another three quarters of a length back to Mythical Magic (Iffraaj) in third.

The Francis-Henri Graffard-trained **Lilac Fairy** (2 f Redoute's Choice - Border Bloom by Selkirk) ran out a convincing winner of the Prix des Sablonnets (Listed, 1600m) at Nantes on Saturday.

Purchased by Blandford Bloodstock / Golden East Horse for €150,000 at the Arqana October Yearling Sale, the filly was having the fourth start of her career and her first in stakes

The two-year-old filly showed a good

attitude to beat Mon Amie Chop (Captain Chop) by half a length with just a nose back to Shenoya (Zoffany) in third. The win also provided Redoute's Choice with his third stakes winner in France.

The two-year-old filly was most recently seen running second in a nursery handicap over a mile at York on 14 October and on Sunday she was able to go one better, defeating Wonderful Gorl (Areion) by half a length with another five lengths back to Sojourn (Iffraaj) in third.

She came into Friday night's contest off the back of a fine victory in the Carlingford Stakes (Listed, 1m2.5f) at the same track and she was able to continue her good form when she got the better of Aneen (Lawman) by half a length with another neck back to Belle Boyd (Oasis Dream) in third.

Goldrush is one of 20 stakes winners for the Juddmonte Farms sire Frankel (Galileo).

British raider **Peach Melba** (3 f Dream Ahead - Nellie Melba by Hurricane Sky) put in an impressive performance when she landed the Grosser Preis Des Gestut Haus Zoppenbroich (Listed, 1600m) at Hannover on Sunday.

The Mark Johnston-trained three-yearold filly, who was having her first start in stakes company, was last sighted winning Breeders' Fillies Series Handicap (1m) at Newmarket, was sent straight to the front by jockey Franny Norton.

When she was asked for her effort approaching the two furlong pole, she found

another gear and eventually beat Vive Marie (Jukebox Jury) by a length and a half with Jasnin (Palace Episode) a further three quarters of a length adrift in third.

The Vincenzo Fazio-trained **My Lea** (3 f Dandy Man - Luvmedo by One Cool Cat) followed up her recent stakes success with another win at stakes level when she landed the Premio Carlo and Francesco Aloisi (Gr 3, 1200m) at Capannelle in Rome on Sunday.

The three-year-old filly came into the race off the back of a success in the Premio Omenoni (Listed, 1000m) in Milan on 15 October and on Sunday she held on well for pressure to beat Zapel (Kyllachy) by a short head with another three quarters of a length back to Imperial Tango (Sageburg) three quarters of a length in third.

The Irish-bred filly was purchased by Alberto Panetta for €13,000 at the Goffs Sportsman's Sale in 2015 and has now won seven of her 17 career starts and amassed €113,985 in career prize money.

My Lea is one of six stakes winners for Dandy Man (Mozart), whose progeny is headed by Hong Kong Group One winner Peniaphobia.

Older Horses

The Tony Martin-trained **Laganore** (5 m Fastnet Rock - Lady Bones by Royal Applause) landed the Premio Lydia Tesio (Gr 1, 2000m) at Capannelle in Rome on Sunday.

The five-year-old mare ran third in the race 12 months ago and she came into this year's renewal off the back of an impressive win in the Lanwades Stud Stakes (Gr 3, 1m1½f).

The five-year-old mare stayed on strongly all the way to the line to eventually beat A Raving Beauty (Mastercraftsman) by a decisive two lengths with another five lengths back to the Archie Watson-trained Absolute Blast (Kodiac) in third

The sire of 123 stakes winners overall, the victory also provided shuttler Fastnet Rock with his 29th Group One winner and trainer Tony Martin's first elite level on the Flat.

The previous day, the Christophe Lotoux-trained **Smart Whip** (6 g Dylan Thomas - Green Girl by Lord Of Men) continued his winning sequence when he won the Grand Prix De Nantes (Listed, 2400m) on Saturday.

The six-year-old gelding had not been sighted since he won Grand Prix de la Ville de Craon-Mayenne (Listed, 2400m) in September having also won his two previous starts and yesterday his fine form carried on when he beat Royalicky (Slickly Royal) by a neck with Mint Julep (Mastercraftsman) a further three quarters of a length away in third.

The Stefano Botti-trained **Time To Choose** (4 c Manduro - Penfection by Orpen) secured his fourth win at stakes level when he won the Premio Ribot (Gr 3, 1600m) at Capannelle in Rome on Sunday.

Most recently seen running third in the Premio Vittorio di Capua (Gr 2, 1600m), Time To Choose ran on strongly to the line to score victory over Royal Julius (Royal Applause) with Aspettatemi (Red Rocks) running home in third.

Time To Choose is one of 29 stakes winners for Darley sire Manduro (Monsun).

The Daniel Paulick-trained **Ostana** (4 f Contat - Oviva by Lomitas) won the Grosser Preis Der Mehl-Mulhens-Stiftung (Gr 3, 2200m) at Hannover on Sunday.

In winning the race the filly was able to follow up her recent success in the Grosser Preis der BMW Niederlassung Hannover (Listed, 2200m) and she did so when she narrowly beat favourite Agathonia (Street Cry) by a neck with another three quarters of a length back to Fosun (Soldier Hollow) in third.

Ostana is one of two stakes winners for her sire Contat (Diktat), the other is Group Three winner Schang.

On that occasion it was 100-1 outsider Prince Of Penzance (Pentire) and Michelle Payne who spoiled the party. But, with experience under his belt and a light campaign up to now, surely it would be foolish to underestimate the seven-year-old gelding.

time. He's switched to last year's winner Almandin (Monsun) as he goes in search of a first Melbourne Cup and Willie Mullins has booked Zac Purton instead.

We have only seen Max Dynamite four times since his near miss of two years ago. He warmed up for a crack at the 2016 Ascot Gold Cup (Gr 1, 2m4f) by finishing third of four in the Henry II Stakes (Gr 3, 2m) at Sandown. His Ascot effort was not much better as he finished tenth of 18 behind star stayer Order Of St George (Galileo).

He spent the next 14 months on the sidelines but the lengthy absence did not stop punters for piling into him in the Guinness Galway Hurdle (2m), Ireland's richest hurd race, in early August.

Backed down from double-figures into 7-2 favourite, he failed to make any sort of impression and never landed a glove on Tigris River (Montjeu).

A confidence booster was needed so Mullins shrewdly decided to send him to Killarney in August for a six-runner event on the Flat. It proved to be a masterstroke as he won convincingly, as his starting price of 4-9 suggested he would.

Max Dynamite has proved he can cope with the hustle and bustle of a Melbourne Cup, he looks in rude health in Werribee and he has sneaked into the race under the radar with some of his international counterparts stealing the spotlight.

David Casey, Mullins' assistant, believes that this is the same Max Dynamite as the one which showed up in 2015, if not better. If he is correct, then expect him to be bang there at the business end.

Tattersalls a Group 1 target for JJ Gordon

ritish raider Blond Me climaxed a huge week for JJ Gordon Bloodstock (FBAA) with a Group 1 victory in the E.P Taylor Stakes (2000m) at Woodbine on Sunday, October 15.

The Andrew Balding-trained mare was purchased by Moonee Valley-based agent Jeffrey Gordon for 65,000gns (AUD 116,255) at the 2013 Tattersalls October yearling sale. She collected the bulk of a \$500,000 purse in Canada and will round off her career in the G1 Hong Kong Vase or G1 Hong Kong Cup in December.

"I think she deserved it," Balding reflected. "She won two Group 2 races at home and was second in the G1 Nassau Stakes. She retires at the end of the season and will probably have one last go in Hong Kong."

Blond Me (Tamayuz) had an Australian connection when targeted by Gordon at Tattersalls – she's a half-sister to English import Glass Harmonium who won the G1 Mackinnon Stakes at Flemington in 2011.

Gordon returned to the Tattersalls October yearling sale earlier this month - just days before Blond Me's career-high victory - to purchase fillies by Dark Angel (2), Kingman, Speightstown and Kodiac for a total spend of 1.62 million guineas (AUD 2.86 million) during Books 1 and 2.

The first Dark Angel cost 400,000gns and is from Soxy Doxy (Hawk Wing), a half-sister to trans-Atlantic stakes winner Millennium Dragon (G3 Appleton Hcp & LR King Charles II Stakes).

The other Book 1 buy also made 400,000gns. A half-sister to Pearl Secret (G2 Temple Stakes), she is by Juddmonte stallion Kingman (Invincible Spirit) who beat Toronado in the G1 Sussex Stakes.

Gordon had a family background in racing when commencing work as a pedigree clerk at Coles Bloodstock in the 1970s. "It was all done manually and meant you absorbed something about every horse researched," he recalled. "It has stayed with me ever since."

Gordon relocated to Dalgety's Melbourne office broadening his knowledge of the industry as an auctioneer, bid spotter and inspector of yearlings. During that time he travelled to Singapore where his uncle John Murray was stable jockey for world-class trainer Ivan Allan. It provided a unique insight into the various racing jurisdictions in South-East Asia.

Gordon also worked with FBAA member Tony Cavanagh at A G Cavanagh & Co before establishing JJ Gordon Bloodstock Consultants with the support of his wife Debbie. He was one of the first agents in Australia to develop the unraced - trial horse market in Hong Kong.

Backing his judgement in the 1990s, Gordon relocated his family to Singapore to join Mick Kent as operations manager and the stable quickly became a major force on the Kranji - Malaysian circuit.

In an industry that is constantly evolving, Gordon's vision to be ahead of the game went to another level in 2010 when he developed a system to evaluate and purchase European horses for both Australia and Hong Kong.

"I chose to do the legwork myself and semi-relocated to France," he said. "I was introduced to Wayne Mitchell and Tony McEvoy and they recognised a unique opportunity."

Sysmo (Fr) was the first horse purchased under the new system after a maiden win at Clairefontaine. He won the LR Seymour Cup and earned black-type at Flemington, Eagle Farm and Morphettville. Other stayers targeted for Mitchell and McEvoy included Big Memory (G2 Herbert Power Stakes), Le Roi (G3 Queen Elizabeth Stakes) and Mouro (G3 Eclipse Stakes).

Gordon has also sourced several Hong Kong stars in Europe. He spotted Akeed Mofeed, Gold Fun and Giant Treasure in maiden company and all three developed into Group 1 winners for owner Sutong Pan.

Akeed Mofeed (Dubawi) stands at Mr Pan's Goldin Farms in South Australia and his first crop are ready to embark on their racing careers with prominent racing stables in South Australia, Victoria and NSW.


