POUNAMU AIMING FOR LUCRATIVE ASCOT DOUBLE

Group One winner up in trip for Ted Van Heemst test

Having claimed some notable scalps in the Kingston Town Classic (Gr 1, 1800m) at his last start, the Alan Mathews-

trained Pounamu (Authorized) will bid to land a lucrative, big-race double in the Ted Van Heemst Stakes (Gr 2, 2100m) at Ascot today.

The six-year-old came from off the pace to register a decisive victory in the Kingston Town Classic on 9 December, and he is stepped

up to 2100 metres for the first time in today's \$400,000 Group Two following that strong-finishing effort.

The son of Authorized (Montjeu) will face just seven rivals this afternoon, including the rapidly progressive, multiple stakes winner Trap For Fools (Poet's Voice), who is set to back up today having made all in the A.T.A. Stakes (Listed, 2200m) on Wednesday.

The presence of the Lindsey Smith-trained front-runner Trap For Fools is a relief to Muchea-based Mathews, with Pounamu performing so effectively off a strong pace at his last start.

"The small field is a concern and whether he stays is something you don't know, but he is bred to be a stayer, being by Authorized," Mathews told ANZ Bloodstock News.

"The horse that raced on Wednesday (Trap For Fools) is a natural front-runner so there should be an honest tempo." *Continued on page 2>>*

Pounamu has had just three starts at 2000 metres in his career, most recently finishing third in the Strickland Stakes (Gr 3, 2000m) in July, and he is yet to race beyond that distance in 37 career outings.

While the step up in trip poses something of a concern for Mathews, he could not be happier with the gelding's progress since his run in the Kingston Town Classic a fortnight ago.

"We are very happy with him. He galloped last Saturday morning and the jockey and I thought he had improved a little bit, if that's possible," Mathews said.

"We haven't had any problems in his prep and I'm happy with where we are at. The jockey rode him well (in the Kingston Town Classic), he settled well and the horse seems to be realising the potential we always thought he had."

Among Pounamu's rivals is the Adam Durrant-trained **Zarantz** (Choisir), with the Listed-winning seven-year-old bidding to leave his last start fifth in the Towton Cup (Listed, 2200m) behind him.

The gelding was transferred to Karnup-based Durrant from Grant and Alana Williams earlier this preparation, and the trainer has been pleased with the gelding in the lead up to the Ted Van Heemst Stakes.

"His runs have been really good, I have been pleased with him in his two runs for us," Durrant told TAB Radio.

"He has continued to come on and he has put on some condition and he looks really well in himself."

"He has promised this a few times and progressed, but when you turn the screws on him and really ask the question, he runs the same sort of race."

"Whether his best is behind him, we are going to find out."

Durrant also saddles two runners in the earlier on the card in the Starstruck Classic (Listed, 1600m), with the in-form mares **Celebrity Dream** (Thorn Park) and **First Affair** (Saxon) due to race from barriers four and seven respectively in the eight-runner race.

Celebrity Dream took out the Jungle Dawn Classic (Listed, 1400m) at her last start, but her trainer harbours concerns over the step-up to 1600 metres today.

"She has got to run the trip out strong, her last start wasn't a true representation of a 1400 metre race, it was very steadily run and was basically run like a 1200," he said.

"It was probably more suitable to her than any horse in the race so she has got to get the mile. I am confident that she will, and I think she has got a little bit of a class edge on most of her rivals."

In contrast, Durrant expects First Affair to be hitting the line strongly and is already eyeing a tilt at the La Trice Classic (Gr 3, 1800m) at Ascot on New Year's Day with the five-year-old mare.

"She is in great form and it was a really good win last start," Durrant said.

"I can see her finishing the race off very hard and hopefully pick up a bit of black type before we go to the 1800 on New Year's Day."

Kent confident Oncidium Ruler can return to form

The Michael Kent-trained Oncidium Ruler (Strategic) will look to improve on two recent placings in country cups when he lines up in the Bertocchi Christmas Masterpiece Handicap (2500m) at Moonee Valley today. The gelding landed a 2000 metre race at the Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) carnival then subsequently ran in the Ballarat Cup (Listed, 2200m) and the Pakenham Cup (Listed, 2500m) where he finished second and third respectively. "We felt we didn't win the race we wanted to win so we're going to give this a go," Kent said. "It's a \$120,000 race and I like

the Valley for him as there can be a little bit of give in it."

Yamazaki chasing MM riches

The unraced Yamazaki (Real Saga) will make her debut in the Magic Million QTIS Two-Year-Old Handicap (900m) at the Gold Coast today in an attempt to make the Magic Millions 2YO Classic (RL, 1200m) field at the same track on 13 January. Yamazaki was impressive when winning a trial at Doomben on 12 December and ran a fast time for the morning. "It was a nice trial but as they say races are something totally different. At least she will get a look at the Gold Coast track with the Magic Millions in mind," Anderson said. "Brad Stewart has

agreed to ride her and it will be interesting to get his opinion after the race."

Bargain buy Holdin' My Own eyes MM start

Holdin' My Own (Spirit Of Boom) will also seek a starting berth in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic when she takes her chance in the first heat of the QTIS Two-Years-Old Handicap (900m) at the Gold Coast today. The filly was purchased by her trainer Les Ross for \$20,000 at the Magic Millions Gold Coast Yearling Sale in March from the Eureka Stud draft and already has shown a affiliation with the Gold Coast, winning her last start at the track. "She will have to run first or second on Saturday or we are in a bit of trouble," Ross said. "But she did a good job last time and she has race experience at the Gold Coast."

Amanaat eyes sixth straight win

Amanaat (Per Incanto) will chase a sixth straight win when he takes his chance in a Benchmark 90 (1200m) at the Gold Coast today. Amanaat has had only six starts for trainer Ben Currie since being bought cheaply in Victoria, winning five and finishing an unlucky second in the other. "Things didn't go right at his first start for us at the Sunshine Coast. He really should be six from six for us," Currie said. "Even with the three kilogram claim last start at Doomben he had 58 kilograms. He really is getting up where it hurts and he gets into Saturday's race under the minimum after a claim. He has drawn very well but it didn't really matter where he drew because he has so much early pace to get across and get a position."

Japonisme seeks from redemption

Chris Waller is hopeful that a change in routine can help Group One winner Japonisme (Choisir) rekindle his desire

to race. Waller has introduced treadmill sessions into the gelding's training regime and also changed his diet in the hope that it will reinvigorate his career. The five-year-old has another opportunity to end his losing streak in Saturday's December Handicap (1400m) at Warwick Farm, but Waller is hopeful rather than confident. "He's certainly the class horse of the race, but he's not the form horse," Waller said. "He's trained off and lost interest."

Lucky Liberty on the hunt for second Christmas Stakes

Trainer Henry Dwyer will be hoping Lucky Liberty (Statue Of Liberty) can land a second Christmas Stakes (Listed, 1200m) at Caulfield on Boxing Day. The six-year-old gelding will be resuming having not been seen since running 18th in The Goodwood (Gr 1, 1200m) in May. "He can work on the soft sand at the beach and do some work on hill at the farm down there," Dwyer said. "The soft sand down there is great

for horses with issues as they don't have to work fast but get the same benefit from it. He's in really good order. He's probably sounder now than before he did his most recent knee chips so the operation has obviously been a success."

Williams hopes Demonstrate can recapture form

Trainer Jason Williams is hoping new acquisition Demonstrate (New Approach) can snap a losing streak that stretches back to November 2016 when he lines up in Tuesday's Christmas Stakes at Caulfield. The five-year-old gelding will be having his first start for the stable having been formerly owned by Godolphin. "It'll be hard because you can't improve a horse off Godolphin, they've got everything in their armoury so my job is just to find that zest for racing and hopefully he can find the form he showed 12 months ago when he won that race on Melbourne Cup day," said Williams. "He's had a piece of work and an unofficial jump-out since we got him."

Destiny's Kiss in good condition

Trainer Joe Pride is hoping Destiny's Kiss (Power Of Destiny) can bounce back from a disappointing display in the Villiers Stakes (Gr 2, 1600m) when he takes his chance in the Summer Cup (Gr 3, 2000m) on Boxing Day at Randwick. The nine-year-old gelding will be looking to improve on his sixth place finish in the race last year. "He's clearly a better horse on wet tracks, particularly over the shorter distances because they can leave him behind a bit," Pride said. "Over 2400 it doesn't matter as much but around 2000 he needs a little bit of help."

Blackwolf Run makes comeback

Blackwolf Run (All Too Hard) will make a return to the track in the VOBIS Gold Carat (1200m) at Moonee Valley today having not been seen since he made his debut at the same track in November 2016. A pulled muscle, a gelding operation and a growth spurt have stopped Blackwolf Run from racing, but trainer Mike Moroney is confident he can run well today. "He wanted to do that when we were getting him ready for the autumn and he ended up pulling a muscle behind," said Moroney. "We got him over that, brought him back but we weren't happy with the way he was going, so we stopped again and gelded him. We brought him back for the spring but he looked ordinary so I tipped him out again."

Secret Lady to run at Randwick

Trainer Gary Portelli has confirmed that Secret Lady (Choisir) will tune up for her tilt in the Magic Millions 2YO Classic at the Gold

Coast on 13 January in the Two-Year-Old Plate (1100m) at Randwick a week today. The filly won the Golden Gift 2YO Plate (1100m) last month and put in an impressive trial under Ben Melham at Warwick Farm earlier this week, with Ben Melham now set to take the ride on the filly, taking over from apprentice Lee Magorrian.

More Sundays impresses in trial

The Bjorn Baker-trained More Sundays (Fastnet Rock), a son of multiple Group One-winning mare More Joyous (More Than Ready) impressed in a barrier trial at Rosehill yesterday. The two-year-old colt finished strongly to claim the 900 metre trial in a performance that now has Baker contemplating the rich juvenile races in Sydney in the early part of 2018. "He's a lovely big horse and we're really happy with the way he's come through this preparation," Baker told Racing.com. "We might give him a little break now and then get him back to trial at the end of January and look at some of the big two-year-old races with him."

Music Magnate well ahead of Christmas Classic

Bjorn Baker was also pleased with Group One winner Music Magnate's (Written Tycoon) winning trial at Rosehill as he is prepared for his tilt in the Christmas Classic (Listed, 1200m) at Randwick a week today. The six-year-old gelding has not been seen since running last in the Kingsford-Smith Cup (Gr 1, 1300m) at Doomben and Baker is confident he can run well on the comeback from injury. "We're really happy with him - he trialled well," Baker told Racing.com. "He's going to run in the Christmas Classic at Randwick over 1200 metres next week and we'll see where that takes us."

Eckstein to return at Randwick

Trainer Kurt Goldman has said Group Three winner Eckstein (I Am Invincible) will also run in the Christmas Classic at Randwick a week today before then heading to the Magic Millions raceday at the Gold Coast on 13 January. The four-year-old ran a good fourth in a 900 metre trial at Rosehill yesterday having last been seen running second in the Myer Classic (registered as Empire Rose Stakes) (Gr 1, 1600m) on 4 November. Oaks target for Earth Angel

Co-trainer David Hayes has said Earth Angel (Animal Kingdom) is progressing well for the autumn after a minor setback saw her miss the Spring Carnival. The daughter of multiple Group One winner Miss Finland (Redoute's Choice) won on debut at Ballarat and has not been seen since she ran fourth in the Fernhill Handicap (Listed, 1600m) and has been earmarked for a tilt in the ATC Australian Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) in the autumn. "She got up to the trialling stage in the spring, and she kicked the wall and went very sore behind, so she had most of the spring in the paddock," Hayes told Racing.com. "She's been back with me a month, moving beautifully, I think the setbacks have been a bonus because she's always been a leggy filly, and she's got a bit stronger."

Fell Swoop moved to Dale's Moruya base

Trainer Matt Dale has said Fell Swoop (Not A

Single Doubt) will be trained out of his Moruya stables base this campaign. The Group Two winner, who has been placed at Group One level on five occasions, reportedly prefers the more relaxed beach lifestyle and Dale has said he will be aiming to bring the gelding back in early March. The six-year-old has not been sighted since he ran last in The Everest (1200m) at Randwick in October.

VRC directors returned

Victoria Racing Club (VRC) directors Peter Fekete and Glenn Carmody have been returned to the club's board via ballot at Friday's annual general meeting. Fekete has served on the VRC board since 1999 and has previously served as the club's treasurer while Carmody was appointed in October this year to fill a casual vacancy. VRC Chairman Amanda Elliott congratulated both directors: "Peter has made a terrific contribution as a VRC director over a number of years. Glenn was appointed by the board for his broad skillset as well as experience in racing. He will be a fantastic asset to the VRC for years to come."

ATC to continue Canterbury track work

Canterbury Park will continue to offer regular Course Proper and Polytrack gallops after a number of leading Sydney stables have strongly supported the Australian Turf Club's (ATC) initiative to invest in and further utilise the racecourse. Trainers will be able to use both surfaces from 6am on scheduled days for horses nominated for the following Canterbury Park Friday night and Saturday metropolitan meetings in January and February, leading into the Sydney Autumn Carnival.

New Zealand

Clarify on song for Manawatu Cup

The Peter McKay-trained Clarify (Savabeel) is in good shape ahead of his tilt at the Manawatu Cup (Gr 3, 2100m) at Awapuni today. The five-year-old capped a consistent run of form with a decisive victory at Ellerslie at his last start on 2 December. "His work has been exceptional and we were going straight to the Dunstan Feeds Final on New Year's Day, but I said to (owner)

Joe Smithies that we'd have a crack at this race," McKay said. "He's down in the weights and the field isn't that strong. If we win, we'll take him out of the Dunstan and I wouldn't be disappointed to be doing that."

Eight Carat aim for Sandrine

A tilt at the Eight Carat Classic (Gr 2, 1600m) on Boxing Day could act as a springboard towards a tilt at the New Zealand Oaks (Gr 1, 2400m) for unbeaten filly Sandrine (Savabeel), according to co-trainer Graeme Rogerson. "We are aiming her for the Eight Carat and I think she is a pretty good horse," said Rogerson, who trains in partnership with his wife Debbie. "It will be a big step up on Boxing Day, but she certainly has got the ability. She's definitely an Oaks filly, Debbie has had that in mind for a long time. We are hoping to head down that track."

Auckland Cup for El Soldado

The Phillip Devcich-trained 11-year-old El Soldado (Colombia) will again be prepared for a tilt at the Auckland Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) on 10 March. The evergreen gelding, who won the Group One in 2016, is set to run third up over 2100 metres at Te Rapa today and will also target the Avondale Cup (Gr 2, 2400m) in February. "He's coming up well again, he doesn't know he's an 11-year-old," Devcich said. "He's still the same and it would be great to get him to the Auckland Cup again. I think he might need this run, but I'll be happy as long as he's finishing off as a lead up to the Avondale Cup."

Volks Lightning ready to resume

The smart Volks Lightning (Volksraad) is reportedly in good order as she prepares to resume at Ellerslie on Tuesday. She will make her return in the Hallmark Stud Handicap (Listed, 1200m), her first run since an unplaced effort in the Sweynesesse Stakes (Gr 3, 1215m) in October. "The break has done her the world of good," said Bailey Rogerson, who will train in partnership with her grandfather Graeme and his wife Debbie from New Year's Day. "She's a genuine contender."

Eleanora retired

The Murray Baker and Andrew Forsman-trained Eleanora (Makfi) has been retired from racing and is currently in foal to champion New Zealand sire Savabeel (Zabeel). The four-year-old was a dual Group Three last season and also finished third in the VRC Oaks (Gr 1, 2500m) at Flemington, amassing over NZ\$270,000 in prize money earnings. She finished fourth first up in the Matamata Cup (Listed, 1600m) on 14 October but was found to have aggravated a previous injury, prompting connections to call time on her racing career.

Asia

Ruthven trials at Sha Tin

The former Ciaron Maher-trained Group One winner Ruthven (Domesday) was given a 1200 metre barrier trial on the dirt at Sha Tin yesterday as he continues to build towards a first start for John Moore. The four-year-old ran out a wide-margin winner of the Queensland Derby (Gr 1, 2200m) when last sighted at Doomben in June, and yesterday he was given a quiet trial under

Tommy Berry, with the heat won by the Danny Shum-trained Group Three winner Lucky Year (Holy Roman Emperor).

International

Dubai Creek Mile to Heavy Metal

The smart Heavy Metal (7 g Exceed And Excel - Rock Opera by Lecture) made all the running to win the Dubai Creek Mile (Listed, 1600m) at Meydan on Thursday evening. The seven-year-old, who was a Group Two winner as a juvenile in Britain and took out the Burj Nahaar (Gr 3, 1600m) over the same course and distance in March, was quickly away under Royston Ffrench and galloped on strongly in the home straight to beat Wild Dude (Wildcat Heir) by four and a half lengths. Stunned (Shamardal) was a further five and a quarter lengths behind in third.

Muarrab back to form in Garhoud Sprint

The Ali Al Rayhi-trained Group One winner

Muarrab (8 g Oasis Dream - Licence To Thrill by Wolfhound) rediscovered some form when landing the Garhoud Sprint (Listed, 1200m) at Meydan on Thursday evening. The eight-year-old, who won the Golden Shaheen (Gr 1, 1200m) in 2016, drew clear in impressive fashion to beat Comicas (Distorted Humor) by six lengths under Dane O'Neill, with My Catch (Camacho) just a short-head further behind in third place.

Etijaah lands The Entisar

The Doug Watson-trained Etijaah (7 g Daaher - Hasheema by Darshaan) stepped up on a disappointing reappearance to run out an easy winner of The Entisar (Listed, 2000m) at Meydan on Thursday evening. The seven-year-old gelding was beaten over 20 lengths first up last month but bounced back to beat the outsider Barreesh (Giant's Causeway) comfortably by six lengths, with Faulkner (Pivotal) a further length and three quarters behind in third place.

Racing Victoria introduce minimum rating for Saturday metro meetings

Racing Victoria (RV) has introduced a new minimum rating requirement for Saturday metropolitan meetings in Melbourne to ensure horses meet an appropriate standard for the level of competition.

The policy comes into effect on 1 February for all Saturday metropolitan meetings including the five stand-alone Saturday country fixtures.

It extends to six Friday night premier meetings at Moonee Valley, the Caulfield Cup (Gr 1, 2400m) and Melbourne Cup (Gr 1, 3200m) carnivals and all public holiday meetings which carry Saturday metropolitan-standard prize money.

The policy will be applied to all races run at these meetings in which horses older than three can compete, including Group and Listed races. No restrictions will apply to two and three-year-old races.

RV executive general manager of racing Greg Carpenter said these meetings were the pinnacle of racing that drive wagering and customer engagement.

"It is therefore important that the horses competing at these meetings meet appropriate standards for the level of competition," Carpenter said.

"It is also important that punters have confidence in the quality and level of competitiveness of horses contesting our premium meetings and we feel that

these new minimum rating requirements better meet that objective."

Carpenter said over the past two racing seasons a total of 71 horses, or 0.9 per cent of starters across these meetings, would have been affected by the change.

He said there were multiple opportunities for horses to lift their rating to the required Saturday metropolitan standard.

Minimum rating requirements:

- Group One, Two and Three - (open sex) minimum 70 and (fillies and mares) minimum 65
- Listed and open handicaps - minimums 65 and 60
- Benchmark 84 and 90 - minimum 60
- Benchmark 70 and 78 - minimum 50
- Benchmark 64 - minimum 45
- VOBIS Gold and Sales Restricted races - minimum 50
- 2YO and 3YO - no rating restriction

Steve looks at the deterioration in the relationship between trainers and stewards in Victoria

Sectors of the racing industry in Victoria appear to be on the brink of losing faith in the integrity management of the sport.

This view has come to a head, in the last week, with the suspension of trainer John Sadler.

It was paraphrased, on Wednesday, by RSN presenter Michael Felgate who said: "Having spoken to the ATA (Australian Trainers' Association) there is a feeling from their constituents that the relationship between trainers and stewards is at an all-time low."

The number of trainers who now declare

that they have 'lost respect' for the stewards is disturbing.

In fairness, Racing Victoria's CEO Giles Thompson, told Felgate: "I am not deaf to those concerns but the core is that these concerns arise through breaches of the rules of racing."

And, of course, you could well argue it matters not what trainers think of stewards.

However, in perception at least, it's a bigger issue than that and surely the concerns of industry participants into the overall performance of integrity services as a whole should not be dismissed out of hand.

The 2016 Bittar Review of the Integrity Structures of the Victorian Racing Industry report listed no fewer than 15 concerns raised in the "the key observations and points arising from stakeholder feedback" and I'd say those concerns are greater now.

Those concerns will not be allayed by the Victorian government, this year, adopting two key recommendations of the report.

They are: "Following extensive consultation with the industry, Mr Bittar has recommended the establishment of a new body, the Victorian Racing Integrity Unit (VRIU) to deliver integrity services for the three codes of racing.

"Mr Bittar also recommended that the appeals and disciplinary system be restructured to remove the appeal to the Victorian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (VCAT) of decisions by

Racing Appeals and Disciplinary Boards and to establish a single cross-code Racing Appeals and Disciplinary Board (RADB).

"The Victorian government has accepted the two key recommendations in principle and will work in partnership with the key racing stakeholders to implement these recommendations over two years."

As recently as Thursday, the Racing Minister Martin Pakula spoke of integrity as being one of the major challenges facing the industry although of course he did not deal with the detail.

Part of the detail is as follows: "The appeal to VCAT be replaced with entitling a disaffected party to appeal on a question of law to the Trial Division of the Supreme Court."

While 'question of law' may be stretched to broaden the grounds of appeal the process will certainly become more onerous, complicated and costly. Participants beware.

The current unease demands a strident statement of reassurance or a commitment to a review of procedure and policy, rather than structure, from Thompson or newly appointed RVL Chairman Brian Kruger.

There is dismay at the Sadler decision.

There is disquiet at the handling of the Lloyd Williams owning-training situation. Trainer or not the trainer?

There is disbelief at the colossal expenditure on major prosecutions which have failed.

There is bewilderment that this week's case of the bid to have racehorse Late Charge reinstated would get as far as the RAB board and demand RVL's (presumably expensive) engagement of a barrister.

In Sadler's case, his behaviour was appalling and deserving of sanction but it was seemingly out of character, borne of exasperation and came from a man who has suffered with depression.

He was suspended for inappropriate conduct. Not for illegal treatments. If there's more to the case, we're entitled to know.

There is concern that stewards' leaks to the media serve as transparency. They do not.

There is concern that nobody is sitting either side or above the stewards to assess the economic opportunity cost of prosecutions.

Prosecutions, in any domain, will not always succeed but surely they must be undertaken judiciously.

There is a view that fines would be more appropriate than suspensions and that this

would circumvent protracted and expensive challenges to decisions.

Rightly or wrongly, there is a pervading view among industry participants that they are all presumed guilty until proven innocent.

Mind you, there are some trainers who will grudgingly acknowledge that chief steward Terry Bailey's 'bull at a gate' approach has produced a more level playing field.

And some would endorse Bailey as the right man for the job - perhaps with a greater level of accountability.

As in all matters, it ought to be about balance. Similarly, with all matters of import, perception can be as important as reality.

That's why I would argue that RVL needs to deal with policy, procedure and perception.

By all means, RVL may vigorously endorse its chief steward and integrity team. If so, it should say so in no uncertain terms.

Reassure us that the integrity team's vigilance has seen a dramatic fall in the number of 'suspicious' races and/or training activities. Assure us that the board has great faith in the

integrity team and in the conduct of racing as a whole in this state.

Perhaps RVL could assure us that ongoing costs will be more assiduously monitored and precisely outline the role of newly appointed integrity chief Jamie Stier.

Goodness knows, the industry could do with some reassurance especially with charges from the Lovani inquiry apparently imminent. Goodness knows where we'll be at if that comes to nought or any ensuing prosecutions fail.
